Hyperscapes Massive Loss of Habitat and the Refugees of the Anthropocene is a multidisciplinary collective research at the intersection among ecologies, contemporary migrations, and the geological era of the Anthropocene. "Hyperscapes", is conceived as a tool to pursue consciousness through critical analysis, archiving, data collection, the agency of mapping, and speculative fabulation we seek evidence for the development of alternative methodological devices, and we raise urgent questions about the desirable futures for the planet, which challenge the role of architecture and design. Can we challenge the possibility of Architecture and Design to engage with more complex spatialities and strategies, envisioning the ecologies of a post-human era as well as alternative forms and patterns of habitation in a more and more post-anthropocentric planet?

Hyperscapes Research Office is an interdisciplinary open-ended working group which focuses on the issues that lie on the intersection of planetary urbanization, climates, politics, landscape, and architecture and it was born in Milan in 2019 in the context of the MSc Program "Architecture, Built Environment, Interiors" of Politecnico di Milano. It was assembled by Konstantinos Venis and Filippo Albertini and later joined by Perikli's Lazarou.
