### **Planning for Social Justice**

Department of Architecture of Urban Studies of the Politecnico di Milano (DASTU), with the contribution of ASSOCIAZIONE DI FONDAZIONI E CASSE DI RISPARMIO ITALIANE SpA (ACRI), in the context of the *Planning for Social Justice* Conference (October 2021).

The selection board announces the **GENERAL RANKING OF MERIT** of the eligible candidates who applied for the YITP 2021 Planning for Social Justice.

The candidates have been evaluated privileging (when possible) their indication of the preferred research centers, against selection and award criteria of excellence, impact, and quality and efficiency of implementation, based on their academic career, of the work-plan and the abstract of the seminar. The final decision is at the incontestable discretion of the selection board. The ranking concerns each research center, who expressed its preferences among the applications. The first candidate in each list is going to be notified about the selection and asked to accept the offer. In presence of any waivers, it will be selected the next candidate in the ranking.

**Within the 29 of August, the successful applicants must send a letter of acceptance by email at [info-yitpcall@polimi.it](mailto:info-yitpcall@polimi.it)** indicating provisionally their preferred visiting period. This will be agreed in with the responsible of each hosting Department, in order to proceed with the administrative procedures to be authorized and assigned by Politecnico di Milano to travel to one of the 7 research centers indicated in the attachment.
