Moving in a narrow space. Towards a new mobility.

Federico Parolotto is Senior Partner at MIC – HUB. He began his career with SOM in the UK and then worked as a partner with Systematica in Milan. As a transport planner, he has been involved on many major urban planning projects worldwide, advising clients ranging from public bodies to important architectural firms, and from technology providers to transport operators.

He was also a member of the expert committee that supported Milan City Council in the drafting of the recently adopted Sustainable Urban Mobility Plan.

He lectured around the world and led numerous research projects, developed with MIC-HUB team, among others the mobility sections for "Arcipelago Italia" for the Padiglione Italia at the Venice Biennale in 2018.

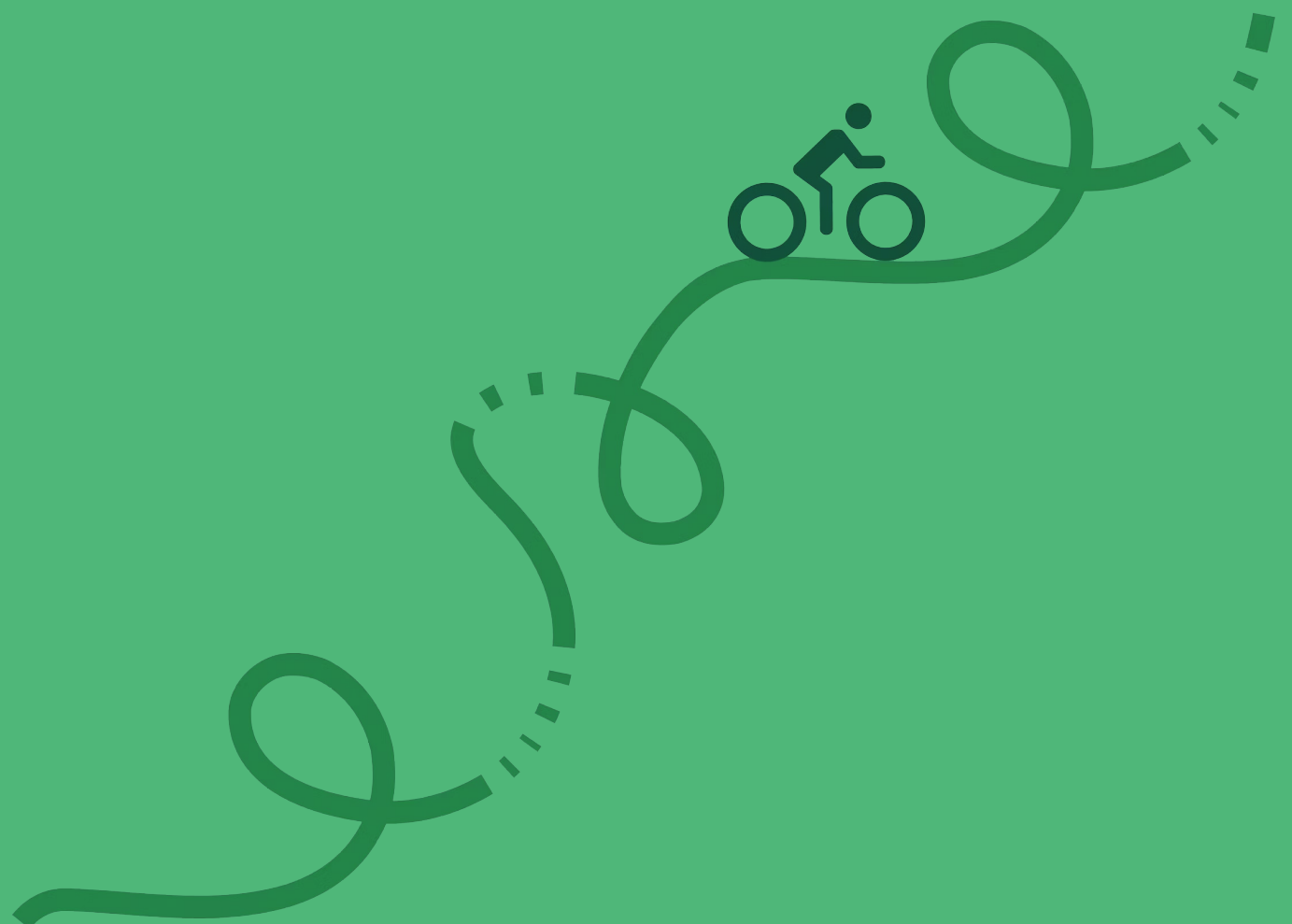
