The Mooca district is a semi-central area of São Paulo undergoing transformation that presents various social, economic, environmental and urban fragilities. PhD SPws2024 reflected on the approaches needed to develop projects and policies for such fragilities. Starting from the different backgrounds of the PoliMi and FAU-USP PhD students and focusing on existing situations, PhD SPws2024 aimed to contribute to a public agenda for the implementation of interventions sensitive to the social, environmental and landscape issues of the area, providing four scenarios and project-oriented critical-interpretative descriptions.
